

## UL Lafayette Emergency Notification System Test

As you know, the University has established an Emergency Notification System (ENS) to alert and inform students and employees that an emergency has occurred. To familiarize yourself on this system, please visit [safety.Louisiana.edu](http://safety.Louisiana.edu). Specifically, if you have not already done so, please subscribe your cell phone to the University's text message service by logging on to [ul.mobilecampus.com](http://ul.mobilecampus.com).

The next step is to test the system to determine its effectiveness. Here is what you need to know:

1. Sometime before 2/28/08, the following test message will be sent to all mobilecampus subscribers:

**“This is a test of the UL Lafayette ENS. Please dial 482-9876 or text a reply of ‘yes’ to confirm receipt”**

2. Once you receive the message, as soon as possible, confirm receipt preferably from a campus phone (dial 29876). You can also confirm receipt by texting a reply of “yes” or dialing 482-9876. Please confirm receipt only once.
3. Please pass this information on to our students so that they may also be prepared for the ENS test.
4. The departmental emergency radios will not be tested at this time. These devices are currently tested weekly (every Wednesday at approximately noon) in silent mode.
